

1st SCCS PANDA CHESS TOURNAMENT

Sunday, Apr. 20 & 27, 2014

DIVISIONS: Session 1: Grades K, 1 and 2 (age 5-7). Session 2: grades 3, 4 and 5 (age 8-12).

REGISTRATION FEE: \$15.00 per child. \$10 for child registered in the SOUTHEASTERN CONNECTICUT CHINESE SCHOOL (WWW.CTSCCS.ORG). Registration fee could be waived on a case by case basis through the CTSCCS Office for students with written request (contact Eddie Yang at <u>xwyang11@yahoo.com</u>). Money and registration form MUST be received by **April 5, 2014**. \$5 late fee will be applied after the deadline.

SCHEDULE: Check in is 11:00 to 11:10 AM for both days. The Player Meeting is at 11:10 AM and all competitors must attend. This is a 4-round, non-elimination tournament - players should plan to participate in all four rounds as follows

Rounds 1&2, 11:20-12:45, Sunday Apr. 20. Rounds 3&4, 11:20-12:45, Sunday Apr. 27.

TIME CONTROL: Time control is G/30 (30 minutes, per player, per game). An extended 10 min is allowed for each player.

PRIZES: In each division, the top finishers will be awarded trophies. Participation awards will be given to non-trophy winners. Awards ceremony will follow the final round and will occur mid-late afternoon, after Round 4 is completed. Ties for rewards (cash along with certificate) will be broken with the following tie-break systems for both sessions.

Panda King's place (first): **\$50** (one winner) Panda Rook's place (second): **\$25** (two winners) Panda Knight's place (third): **\$15** (three winners)

SUPERVISION: Good behavior of all participants is expected. A compliment of shaking hands after each game is always encouraged for all players. All participants should keep quiet during and after each session. If it becomes clear that a player behaves inappropriately, the player will be prohibited to compete further and will be asked to leave. All players 8 years old and younger must have a parent/guardian present for the entire tournament. Please note that parents are not allowed in the competition area once a round begins.
