Approaching China (2)

- Program Overview: This program is for those whose family languages are not Chinese. Students will learn very basic Chinese language skills while exploring rich Chinese culture. In the class, students will be exposed to a variety of cultural components including Chinese children music, calligraphy, painting, food, stories, etc. Students will participate in hands-on learning activities such as shopping, asking directions, time and weather, self- introduction, etc.
- Learning Objectives: Write and speak own Chinese name, greet Chinese people, self-introduction (Chinese name, age, how many family members and who they are, etc.), answer simple questions, understand some commonly used words and expressions, understand basic information on numbers, sizes, colors, weather, etc., recognize characters with help from visuals, sing a simple children song (or perform Chinese children dance), recite a simple Chinese children poem, etc.
